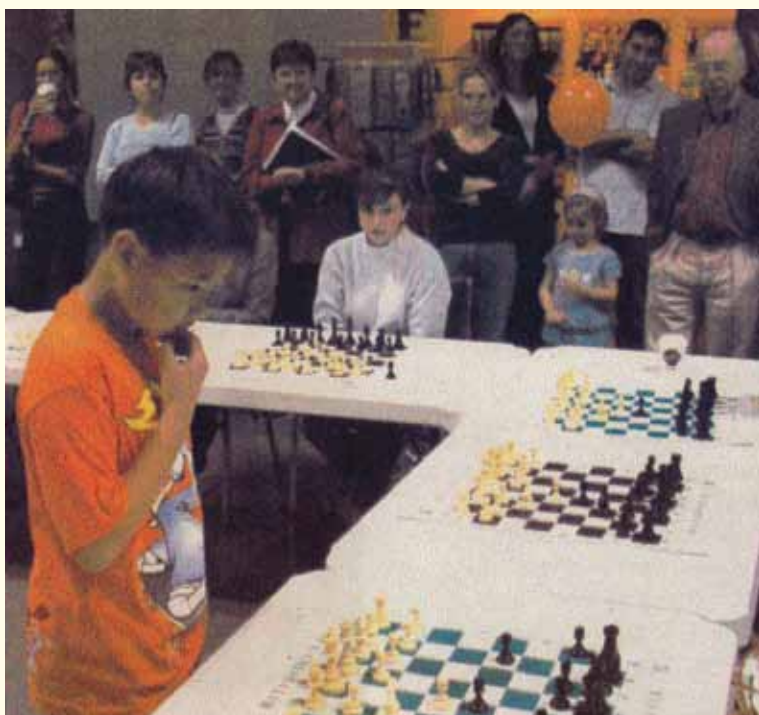

### INSTRUCTOR LLOYD MAI BIOGRAPHY



- Canadian Chess Master Certificate at age 14
- Chess instructor at the ABC Take-off program hosted by the Association for Bright Children of Ottawa.
- Canadian Chess Champion Grades 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 11, 12
- North American Chess Champion grade 3 and 6.
- Represented Canada at Pan American Chess Championships 2003 (Colombia)
- Represented Canada at the World Youth Chess Championships in 2003 (Greece), 2005 (France), 2007 (Turkey), 2008 (Vietnam).
- Received 2nd place at the World Youth Chess Championships for under 16 teams in 2008
- Recognized as Role Model for Canadian Children in Chess by The Chess and Math Association of Canada
- At 10 years old Lloyd was the first child to play simul chess against 32 players at the same time in Ottawa for a United Way fund raising campaign hosted by Industry Canada in 2003. Lloyd won 25, and lost 7. Live on CJOH television – Focus program.
- At 11 years old Lloyd played simul chess against 20 players at the same time in Ottawa for a United Way fund raising campaign hosted by Industry Canada in 2004. Lloyd won every game. Interviewed by CBC television, the Ottawa citizen news, Center Town news.
