

Scholarship Application and Selection Criteria

Overview of the Marion Dewar Scholarship Fund

The Marion Dewar Scholarship Fund was established by the Ottawa Community Immigrant Services Organization (OCISO) in 2009, in honour of the late Marion Dewar, former Mayor of Ottawa. The goal of the Scholarship Fund is to provide financial support to foster academic and leadership excellence in immigrant and refugee youth. The fund will supplement the tuition and supplies required for their post-secondary education in the National Capital Region.

Each year, a scholarship of \$1000 each will be awarded to two immigrant and refugee youth.

The Criteria

The candidate must:

- Be a resident of the National Capital Region for at least one year.
- Be an immigrant or refugee youth.
- Demonstrate significant financial need.
- Be a graduating high school senior or from another accredited secondary institution in the National Capital Region.
- Be enrolled in first year of a first degree program or certificate program for the first time at an accredited post-secondary institution as a FULL-TIME student.
- Have a good academic standing: A minimum GPA of 3.3 on a 4.0 scale or 80%.
- Demonstrate leadership skills and community involvement (in addition to the forty hours of community service requirement for high school students).

Terms and Conditions for the Marion Dewar Scholarship Fund Applications

- Candidates can receive the MDSF only once.
- Completed applications must be postmarked to OCISO by August 8, 2011.
- All candidates' applications are subject to a reference check.
- All scholarship recipients must agree to be publicly recognized and be available to attend the Scholarship Presentation Ceremony. Date to be determined.

- The Selection Committee endeavours to achieve gender parity in the selection of qualified candidates for the scholarship.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

Please send the following documents along with a completed application form:

- A two-page essay explaining how this scholarship will impact your goals and how you satisfy the eligibility criteria (academic achievement, school and community involvement, extra-curricular activities, aspirations and financial need).
- A photocopy your latest official transcript of six Grade 12 courses with an overall 80% average.
- A letter of recommendation from a teacher/guidance counsellor in the current academic year.
- Proof of community work. Please provide at least one reference letter from a community member or your supervisor in an organization that benefited from this initiative. Copies of certificates and / or participation letters will be accepted.
- Proof of resident status in the National Capital Region (we will accept one of the following documents: proof of address, letter from employer, letter from landlord or neighbour, etc. to establish that you have been living in the NCR for at least 1 year).
- A detailed statement indicating the amount of money expected from various sources (family/relatives, personal savings, employment, loans, and scholarships).
